



KleanFlo Service Update

Customer notice - 30 June 2026

Summary

An update has been released to improve schedule management, audit list behaviour, and site designation placement in KleanFlo.

The changes help users manage records more clearly and reduce the chance of schedules or designations being handled incorrectly.

What has changed

- The schedule delete action now uses clearer wording: Delete schedule.
- Schedules with timesheets already included in payroll cannot be deleted.
- Deleted audits are removed from audit lists more reliably.
- New site designations are placed into zones more intelligently.

What this means for users

- Users get clearer guidance before removing schedules.
- Payroll-linked schedule records are protected from accidental deletion.
- Site designations are easier to place into the correct zone.

What to do

1. Refresh KleanFlo or sign back in if the current session has expired.
2. Check any warning shown before confirming schedule deletion.
3. Use the normal schedule-ending process where a schedule is linked to payroll.
4. Allocate new designations to the correct zone when a site has multiple zones.
