



KleanFlo Service Update

Customer notice - 30 July 2026

Summary

A hotfix update has been released for KleanFlo scheduling today.

The update focuses on schedule start dates, planned work creation, and clearer checks when schedule hours are reviewed.

What has changed

- Schedule start dates are now checked more clearly so older dates cannot be selected by mistake.
- Fast contract setup now gives clearer confirmation when a schedule starts before today and planned work will be created from a later date.
- Schedule over-hours warnings now compare planned work more accurately across the affected days.
- Future schedules are handled more safely when planned work and schedule warnings are calculated.

What this means for users

- Users should receive clearer guidance before saving schedule dates that could create unexpected historic planned work.
- Office teams should see more accurate warnings when schedule hours may exceed the contract allowance.
- Future-dated schedules should no longer affect current planning checks before they become active.

What to do

1. Review any schedules created or edited today where the start date is before today.
2. Check planned work start dates before completing fast contract setup.
3. Re-test schedule hour warnings on contracts with overlapping or future schedules.
